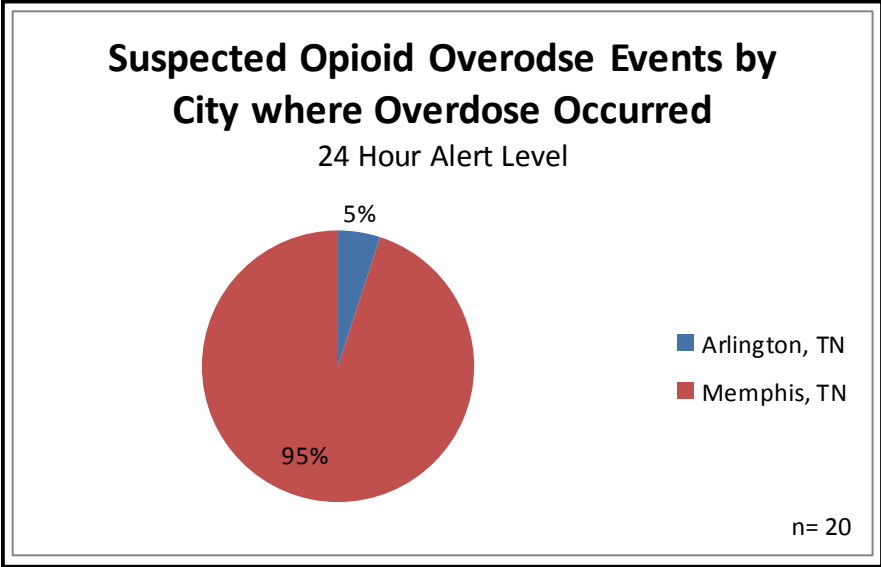


## Spike Alert Report—Suspected Overdose Events

A spike alert means that the Health Department has observed a significantly higher number of overdose events during a period of time than would be expected based on prior data.

### 24 Hour Spike Alert—8/30/2019: 20 Total Reported Overdose Events, 3 Fatal

**Sex:** 67% Male

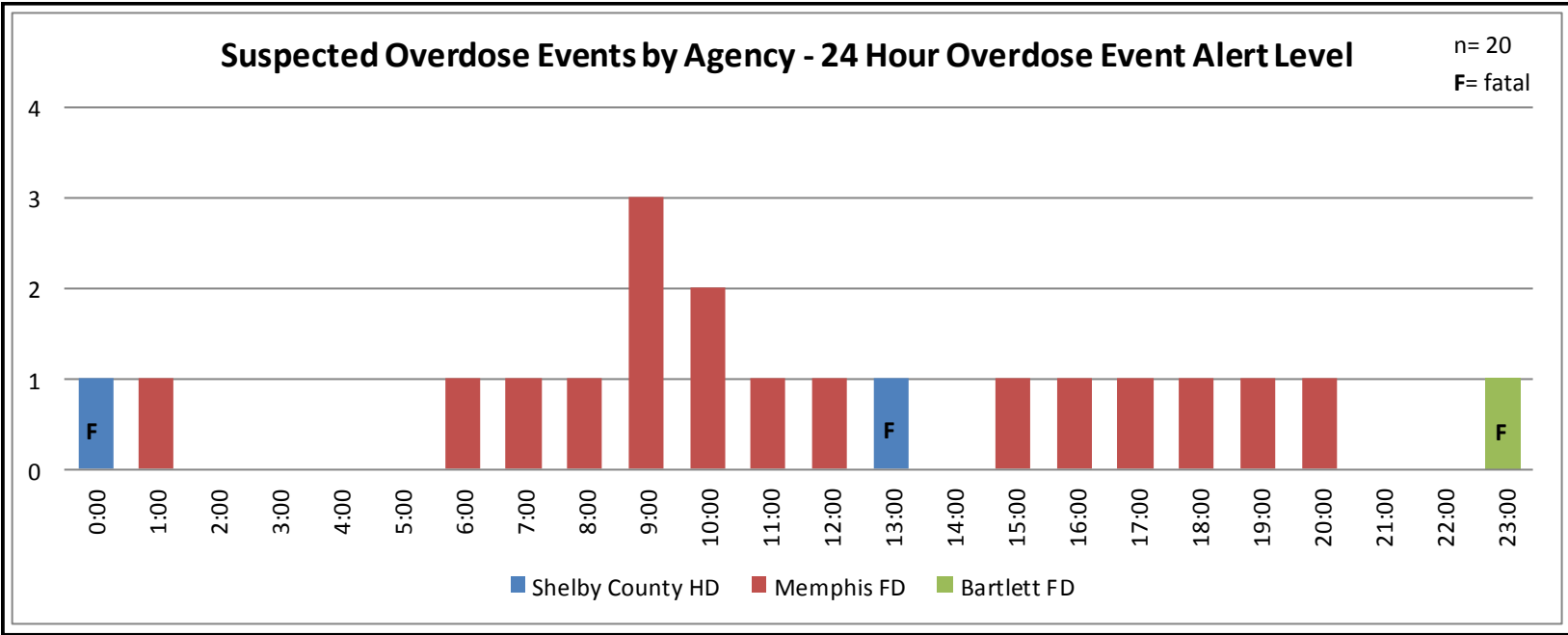
