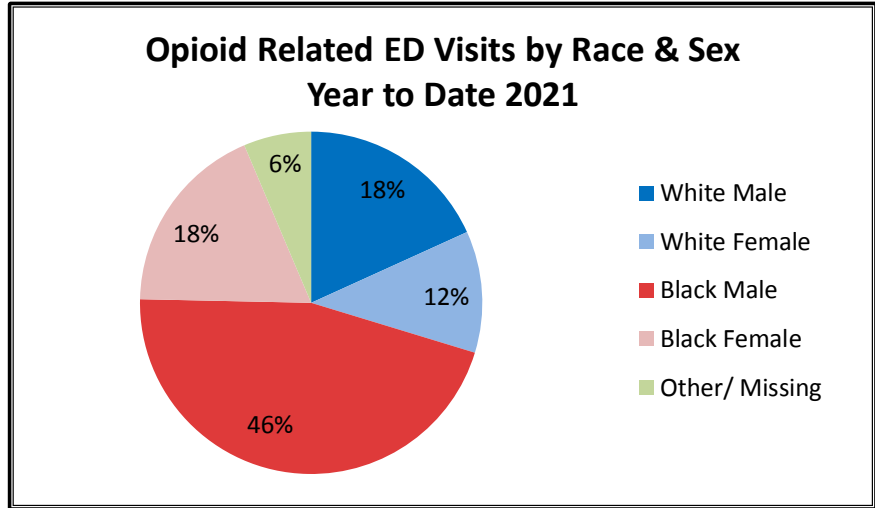
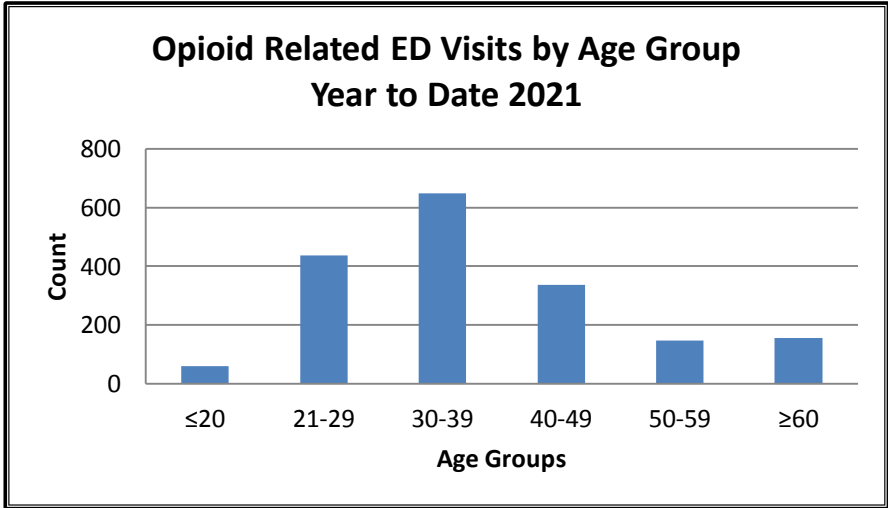
Opioid Related Emergency Department (ED) Visits, Shelby County Residents– Weekly Report

MMWR Week 52 (Dec 26 – Jan 1): ED Visit Count: **34**

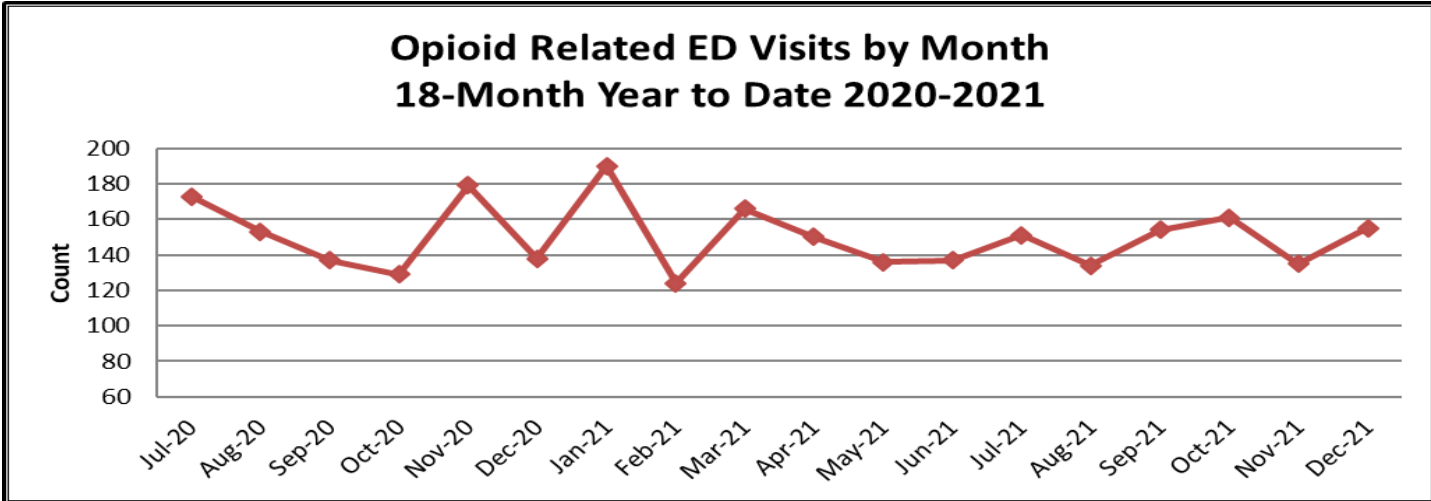
Reported Suspect Drug Overdoses: **45**

Data Notes: Data is retrieved from ESSENCE-TN. 11 of the 12 Shelby County hospitals with emergency departments submit data to ESSENCE-TN.

The data represents any emergency department encounter for Shelby County residents with the term “heroin, opioid, opiate, or fentanyl” listed as a chief complaint. The data also represents any encounter with an ICD-10 code designated for heroin and opioids.

Currently all reporting hospitals in Shelby County submit ICD-10 codes.

Emergency responses to suspect drug overdose data comes from HIDTA ODMAP for Shelby County 2021.
